



## Research and Institutional Capacity Strengthening in Non Communicable Diseases Call Remit and Guidance (Deadline:31st March 2021 at 1 pm UK time).

#### Category: Sciences

About: NIHR Global Health Research Centre's will provide a sustainable platform for high-quality applied health research in LMIC institutions to address local needs and improve health outcomes in response to the growing global burden of disease.

#### **Priority Areas:**

NIHR is seeking Global Health Research Centre application that take an inerdisciplinary approach across participating institutions to address research in the following areas:

- 1. Institutional research plans that focus on NCDs in LMIC propulations, at any stage(s) across the lifespan (i.e. from pregnancy/foetal development through childhood and adolescence to all stages of adulthood including aging adults).
- 2. Drive innovation in the development and evaluation of cost-effective, context-relevant interventions and strategies to improve the primary and secondary prevention, treatment, management and care of NCDs and multiple long-term conditions in LMICs, which could increase the global evidence base through research on (but not limited to): Interventions to preent NCDs in LMICs focussing on more than one NCD cross partner institutions, interventions to improve screening, diagnosis, treatment, management (or lifestyle modification plans) and care of patients with NCDs prevalent in LMICs, Interventions for the prevention of the development, and treatment, of NCDs in children and young adults, driven by malnutrition and/or proverty.
- 3. Scalable treatment and care approaches that integrate the management of NCDs with other diseases and multiple long-term conditions/con-morbidities (including infectious/communicable diseases and mental health), in LMICs.
- 4. New NCD treatment packages, or new models of care and community-based interventions that integrate both social and biomedical sciences, in order to scale up and maximise the impact of existing interventions.
- 5. Research to strengthen healthcare systems and delivery models in low resource settings and increase health equity in LMICs, for improved diagnosis, treatment, amage, emt amd care fpr tipse affected bu MCDs.

#### Eligibility:

The NIHR Global Health Research programme supports high-quality applied health research for the direct and primary benefit of people in low-and middle-income countries (LMICs) on the OECD Development Assistance Committee (DAC) list, using Official Development Assistance (ODA) funding.


