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Establishment of LUMHS Public School for underprivileged community

Objective/ Overview:

Background

In Pakistan particularly in Sindh province the literacy rate is lowest among all provinces. LUMHS is situated in a rural and underprivileged area of Sindh. Looking at the situation leadership of university initiated this project to promote education.

The program overview

To provide quality education to underprivileged students, empowering them to break the cycle of poverty and become productive members of society. LUMHS has initiated a public school in campus which provides free of charges education to hundreds of children from underprivileged communities, the school does not only offers free education to children of domestic staff and local community but it also provides free books/ study packs at the beginning of each academic year. This initiative is a joint effort of LUMHS students (SDG Volunteers), teaching faculty and Administration. The students play primary role i.e., motivating street children and underprivileged group of people to get registered in LUMHS public school where they can get free education and secondly in a week different groups of students take some of their teaching classes.

Services offered by LUMHS

- Purpose-built school building
- Well-equipped classrooms
- Library and resource center
- Playground and sports facilities
- Free study packs

Programs and Services:

- Free education to underprivileged students
- Health services (medical check-ups, vaccinations)
- Extracurricular activities

Faculty and Staff:

1. Qualified teachers
2. Trained staff (administrative, support)

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1. Improved academic performance
2. Increased enrollment of children to school

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Community outreach activity for education by LUMHS SDG Volunteers:

Activity Title: "Empowering Street children through Education and Motivating them to be enrolled in schools"

Objective/Overview

To inspire and motivate street kids to pursue education, emphasize its value and potential for a better future by going to school. The public schools are available for children, but we realized the need of motivation to the community to start going to school. Therefore, our SDG volunteer students arrange sessions with children who were not enrolled in any schools, highlighting the importance of education. LUMHS continues such session with the community as a result the enrollment in schools is increasing. The children were given information about schools nearby and how to get registered.

Activity Details:

The activity took place on 3rd July 2023 in a village near by the Liaquat University of Medical and Health Sciences.

1. Interactive Sessions: LUMHS students conduct interactive sessions with street kids, focusing on:

- Importance of education
- Benefits of attending school
- Overcoming obstacles and challenges
- Setting goals and aspirations

2. Motivational Talks: SDG volunteer students delivered motivational talks, emphasizing the significance of education in breaking the cycle of poverty.

Impact:

- Inspired Street kids to enroll in schools.
- Increased awareness about the importance of education.
- Fostered a sense of hope and motivation among street kids.
- Encouraged LUMHS students to become role models and mentors.
