Library services are provided **free of cost** to all enrolled students and alumni of the university. The network includes the **Central Library**, a **state-of-the-art new library**, and several **departmental libraries**, all equipped with modern facilities and a rich collection of academic resources.





The Central Library has been developed as a community-oriented knowledge hub, emphasizing inclusivity and outreach. It is particularly focused on providing access to children from underprivileged and underserved communities, helping bridge educational disparities. The initiative ensures that children—regardless of socio-economic background—can access quality learning materials, books, and a supportive environment that nurtures a love for reading and lifelong learning.

Sharing Library resources with community

To extend its impact, LUMHS has formally informed regional schools about the facilities and services available at the New Library. Schools, especially those with **limited or no library infrastructure**, are invited to utilize the New Library's resources for the academic and intellectual benefit of their students.













Computer-Based Examination Center

Liaquat University of Medical and Health Sciences has established a purpose-built, modern Examination Centre. This initiative has been taken to ensure merit-based examinations for the general public, particularly for high-stakes entrance tests.

The Centre is designed to guarantee secure, fair, and transparent administration of all examinations, entrance, routine, and professional. It has revamped the examination mechanism at LUMHS by transforming traditional paper-based tests into computer-based examinations, including written assessments and objective structured formats.

Enable fast, reliable scoring, reporting, and appeals processing.


Key Facilities

He had discussions with students and was inspired by their idea to empowering street children through education and started LUMHS public school, a purpose-built building within the campus. Background

In Pakistan particularly in Sindh province the literacy rate is lowest among all provinces. LUMHS is situated in a rural and underprivileged area of Sindh. Looking at the situation university students, teaching faculty and administration jointly initiated this project to promote education.

The program overview

To provide quality education to underprivileged students, empowering them to break the cycle of poverty and become productive members of society. LUMHS has initiated a public school in campus which provides free education to hundreds of children from underprivileged communities, the school does not only offer free education to children of domestic staff and local community but it also provides free books/study packs at the beginning of each academic year. This initiative is a joint effort of LUMHS students (SDG Volunteers), teaching faculty and Administration. The students play primary role i.e., motivating street children and underprivileged group of people to get registered in LUMHS public school where they can get free education and secondly in a week different groups of students take some of their teaching classes.

This initiative reflects LUMHS's dedication to social responsibility and its ongoing efforts to bridge educational gaps by empowering the next generation through knowledge and mentorship.




















Free Access to Educational Resources


